Design Guidelines For Altering "S" AND "E" Type Bushings



Design Guidelines For Altering "E" Type Bushing Retainer



Guidelines And Recommendations:

1. BUSHING BODY SHOULD BE CLEANED OF ANY MATERIAL IN SPH. RAD. AND THREADED AREAS BEFORE REASSEMBLING. SHOULDER BUSHING THREAD IS "LEFT-HAND".
2. CAUTION ATTENTION SHOULD BE TAKEN NOT TO DAMAGE TIP. TREAT TIP LIKE A GLASS OR CERAMIC MATERIAL.
3. DO NOT LUBRICATE OR USE ANTI-SEIZE ON THREADS.
4. RETAINER MUST BE TORQUED ONTO THE BUSHING BODY USING A TORQUE WRENCH AT 35 FT-LBS (RETAINER HAS A .81 HEX.). RETAINER THREAD IS "RIGHT-HAND".
5. "E" TYPE RETAINER MUST BE MODIFIED AND SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THE BODY BEFORE MACHINING RUNNER OR PART CONTOUR INTO RETAINER. SEE DESIGN GUIDELINES FOR ALTERING "E" TYPE BUSHING RETAINER. WHEN MACHINING IS COMPLETE, REASSEMBLE RETAINER ONTO BUSHING BODY USING SPECIFIED TORQUE (SEE NOTE #4).
6. THE THERMAL EXPANSION FACTOR SHOULD BE CONSIDERED PRIOR TO ASSEMBLING THE BUSHING INTO THE MOLD.
7. WHEN HANDLING BUSHING, USE CAUTION AS TO NOT DAMAGE HEATER AND THERMOCOUPLE LEADS.
8. WAIT A MINIMUM OF 5 MINUTES AFTER SET POINT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED FOR SUFFICIENT HEAT TO TRANSFER INTO THE TIP BEFORE MOLDING.
9. ALWAYS USE A CLOSED LOOP HEATER ON THE MACHINE NOZZLE TIP AND PLACE AS CLOSE TO THE BUSHING RADIUS END AS POSSIBLE.
10. PROVIDE MAXIMUM WATER COOLING IN THE "A" PLATE AND/OR CAVITY INSERT AROUND GATE.
11. ROUTE WIRES THROUGH MACHINE PLATEN AND TO DME CONTROLLER.
12. HEATER IS 700 WATTS / 240 VOLTS AND LEADS ARE 5 DEG FROM CENTERLINE.
13. THERMOCOUPLE IS 5 DEG FROM CENTERLINE.

Square Coil Heaters are supplied with 50" long leads, 24 gage.

Heaters are 240 VAC.

2 power leads are BLACK or MULTI COLOR

1 ground lead is GREEN, 24 Gage.

Thermocouples are "J" Type.

Thermocouples are supplied with:

1 T/C lead is WHITE and negative (-) constantan (non-magnetic).

1 T/C lead is BLACK and positive (+) iron (magnetic).
